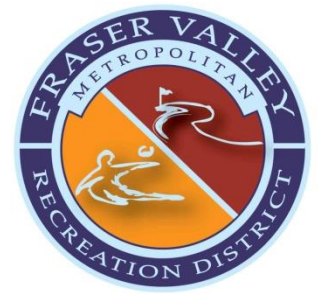

GENERAL STATEMENT OF DUTIES: Individuals in this position are responsible for officiating adult ice hockey games for the Fraser Valley Metropolitan Recreation District at the IceBox Ice Rink.

PRINCIPAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES (ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS):

- Responsible for ensuring the safety of participants by calling penalties and violations in a timely manner and in accordance to USA Hockey and FVMRD League rules
- Inspect ice surface, goals, nets, timing and scoring device prior to the start of each game to ensure equipment is in safe operating condition
- Review score sheets and make recommendations for player discipline based on game penalties
- Officials will monitor behavior, play, and actions of participants prior, during, and after the game to maintain safety values, hockey rules, sportsmanship and general protocol
- Officials must react in a timely manner to penalties and other discipline issues
- Be familiar with all emergency and security procedures, including fire drills.
- Assist in the security of the rink building to include, but not limited to, locking and closing all doors at the end of each night.
- Respond to injuries or incidents as they occur. Contact proper authorities as needed.
- Must be willing to work nights
- Provide customer service in a responsible, service-oriented manner that promotes safety

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

- 18 years of age or older.
- Possess proficient ice-skating skills.
- Demonstrated knowledge of USA Hockey rules from past work history and/or playing experience.
- One (1) or more years of customer service experience.
- Must be able to handle stressful situations while communicating professionally.

WORKING CONDITONS:

- Work is performed mainly outside; therefore, employee will be exposed to the elements.
- Physical Labor is expected of employee.
