

Job Summary:

Under the direct supervision of the golf course superintendent, assistant golf course superintendent, and the maintenance staff foreman, the chief equipment operator will work on a diverse range of activities involved with golf course maintenance and construction. Operates all equipment in the mowing, cultivation, and construction of the golf course and other District facilities. Does semi-skilled grounds construction and maintenance work and performs related tasks as required.

Duties and Responsibilities:

Will include, but not limited to...

- 1. Skillfully operate all maintenance, construction, and mowing equipment safely and efficiently on grounds owned or operated by the District.
- 2. Assist in the maintenance and construction of facilities on grounds owned or operated by the District.
- 3. Participate in daily maintenance tasks including course set-up, greens mowing and bunker grooming.
- 4. Assist in the application of fertilizer and chemicals to grounds owned or operated by the District.
- 5. Assist in the maintenance and repair of irrigation systems owned or operated by the District. Participates in capital improvements to piping and drainage infrastructure.
- 6. Perform other duties and assignments as directed by the supervisors, including assignments that may be outside the primary area of employment.
- 7. Comply with all District and departmental rules, regulations, policies, and procedures.

Interaction:

1. Interaction will be with supervisors, employees, general public, and Board of Directors.

Qualifications:

- 1. Basic knowledge of tools, methods, and materials used in golf course and grounds landscape construction and maintenance work.
- 2. Willing to take an active part in golf course maintenance work by suggesting to supervisor ideas intended to improve efficiency, quality, or output.
- 3. Valid Colorado driver's license.

Physical and Mental Demands:

- 1. This is strenuous work requiring good corrected vision, and hearing. Climbing, hiking, balancing, stooping, kneeling, reaching and lifting are required.
- 2. Must be able to work indoors/outdoors in all weather conditions.

Working Conditions:

- 1. Work is performed mainly outside; therefore, employee will be exposed to the elements.
- 2. Fertilizer and chemicals are used. Employee will be required to read all safety data sheets. Supervisor will also explain any safety precautions that must be followed while handling these materials.
- 3. Physical Labor is expected of employee.
